She told that how to file patent application in India and What to do? She said intellectual Property Rights is a collective term for different IP rights to protect Different types of creative or Scientific/ Technological works.

She told patent is an exclusive right granted by sovereign or state for a limited period, to an applicant to stop others from making, using, exercising, vending and importing an invention in exchange for disclosing it in the patent specification.
